a) Education and Reconciliation Week (September 25th to October 4th)

Chair Darlene Angeconeb went through the pamphlet that was sent out to the Committee regarding the Education and Reconciliation Week.

There were some revisions for Lyn-Marie's events on September 28th and 29th. The Zoom link and event times were changed.

Tiffany Thompson will revise the pamphlet and circulate it to the Committee. The pamphlet will be distributed on Wednesday, September 22nd to local businesses around the area for the public.

The celebration of Equay-Minis would be postponed until the Spring of 2022. The Committee will revisit the planning of this event at that time.

b) <u>Update on Motions to Council regarding MTO signage, Airport signage and Wayfinding signage – Michelle Larose</u>

Michelle advised that she does not have the cost yet for the requested signage and therefore could not bring the report to Council at the last meeting.

She is meeting with the MTO this week regarding the population signage. Staff are working on obtaining quotes for the Wayfinding and Airport signage.

Members of the Committee would also speak with the Elders in the community about why these traditions are so important in the Indigenous burial process and bring the information to the next meeting for the Committee to review.

She said that the Sub-Committee has developed a work plan. It is hoped that the process will be concluded in the Spring of 2022.

Michelle advised that the Municipality could provide a copy of the application that was submitted to NIB Trust for funding.
